Meningococcal, Hepatitis B and Human Papillomavirus 9

In previous years Peterborough Public Health nurses visited each school at least three times (three rounds) during the school year to offer free Meningococcal, Hepatitis B, and Human Papillomavirus 9 (HPV) vaccine to all grade 7 students, and some grade 8 students who need to complete their vaccine series.

This year we will be adjusting our schedule to <u>two rounds</u>. The school vaccine team is currently completing round one, and will visit schools again between March and May. The dates for these clinics have already been confirmed with your individual schools and remain unchanged. **All previously scheduled second round clinic dates between November 20th and January 30th are cancelled.** Students will still be offered the same vaccines based on parent consent, but may receive more doses (up to three) at a single visit.
