#### **Boomerang Lunch**

One of the things we do at Highland Heights is to use the idea of a 'boomerang lunch'. What this means is that anything you send to school in your child's lunch also comes home. This means garbage, juice boxes etc. We try and make sure that there is anything that will make a real mess in the lunch bags, but everything else goes home. This helps cut down on garbage at school, but also helps children stay safe during the eating part of lunch.
