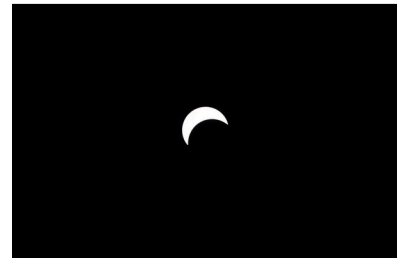
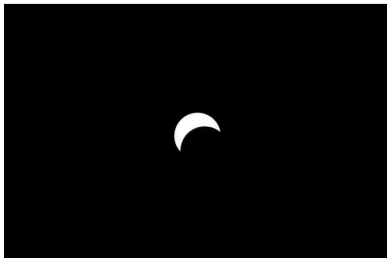
Message from the Principal

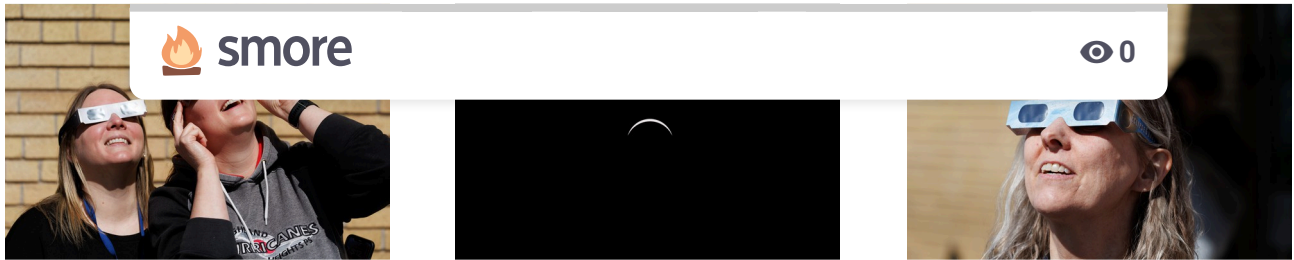
Hello everyone!
